

Privacy Notice pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 and the applicable legislation governing the website www.fimoworld.com

S.p.A., Tax Code and VAT No. 05954970157, Certified Email (PEC): fimo@pec.fimoworld.com, Email: fimo@fimoworld.com, with its registered office at Corso Italia 22, Milan (MI), Italy, and its administrative and operational offices at Via Belvedere 11, 20861 Brugherio (MB), Italy, and Via Campobello 34/A, 00071 Pomezia (RM), Italy, in its capacity as Data Controller (hereinafter, the "Controller"), hereby informs you, pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (the "GDPR") and the applicable legislation on the protection of personal data (the "Privacy Legislation"), that the personal data voluntarily provided by you will be processed in compliance with the applicable laws and the principles of fairness, lawfulness, transparency, and confidentiality set forth therein. Please note that users may browse the website without providing any personal data by disabling cookies in accordance with the procedure described in the relevant section of this website.

1. SUBJECT MATTER OF THE PROCESSING

The personal data processed by the Company through the Website may include:

- Browsing data, including IP addresses collected through cookies or the domain names of the computers used by users accessing the Website, the numerical code indicating the status of the server's response (successful request, error, etc.), and other parameters relating to the user's operating system and IT environment.
- Data voluntarily provided by users, such as first name, last name, email address, telephone number, and any other information submitted by the user.
- Data collected through cookies (as described in the Website's Cookie Policy, to which reference is made) or similar technologies.
- Data relating to interactions with the Website, including, by way of example and without limitation, participation in initiatives, promotional campaigns, and similar activities.

2. PURPOSES OF THE PROCESSING

Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:

- a) Compliance with legal obligations arising from applicable laws, regulations, national and European Union legislation, or requirements imposed by the competent authorities.

The provision of personal data for this purpose is mandatory by law. Failure to provide such data will prevent the Company from carrying out the activity or service requested by you.

b) Performance of contractual obligations.

The provision of personal data for these purposes is necessary for the performance of the contract. Failure to provide such data will make it impossible for the Company to provide and manage its services.

c) Marketing activities, including the sending of advertising material and promotional communications relating to products and/or services provided or promoted by the Controller, by email, SMS, or other electronic means, including information about promotional offers and free gifts.

The provision of personal data for this purpose is voluntary. Refusal to provide consent for such processing will prevent the Company from carrying out the marketing activities described above but will not affect your ability to use the Company's products or services for the primary purposes set out above.

3. LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING

The legal bases for the processing of your personal data are as follows:

- For or the purpose referred to in Section 2(a): compliance with a legal obligation;
- For the purpose referred to in Section 2(b): the performance of a contract;
- For the purpose referred to in Section 2(c): your freely given consent.

4. METHODS OF PROCESSING

Your personal data will be processed using paper-based, electronic, and/or telematic means and in accordance with appropriate technical and organizational security measures designed to ensure the security, integrity, and confidentiality of your personal data.

5. RECIPIENTS OF PERSONAL DATA

The personal data collected through the Website will be processed exclusively for the purposes described above and, in a manner, designed to ensure the highest level of security and confidentiality. Under no circumstances will your personal data be disclosed to the public.

However, your personal data may be communicated to parties who are legally entitled to access such data pursuant to applicable laws or regulations, or in compliance with orders issued by competent authorities. Your personal data may also be accessed by the Controller's employees and collaborators, acting under its authority and duly authorized to process personal data, including system administrators where appropriate. The data may also be made available to third-party service providers (such as hosting providers, IT support providers, software and technology companies, communication agencies, and similar service providers) that perform outsourced services on behalf of the Controller. Such parties have been formally appointed as Data Processors pursuant to Article 28 of the GDPR and process personal data only on the Controller's documented instructions.

The Controller implements appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risks associated with the processing activities. In any event, data subjects may request from the Controller an up-to-date list of the appointed Data Processors at any time.

6. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

The personal data collected will be retained for the duration of the business relationship and for as long as necessary to achieve the purposes described in this Privacy Notice. In any event, such data will not be retained for more than ten (10) years from the date of the last commercial contract, unless a longer retention period is required in connection with disputes.

Where the user has provided consent for the processing of personal data for marketing purposes (for example, by subscribing to the newsletter), such data will be retained until the data subject withdraws their consent.

7. TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION

As a general rule, users' personal data are not transferred outside the European Union. Should such a transfer become necessary, the Controller will ensure that it is carried out in accordance with the applicable provisions of the GDPR. In particular, the Controller will adopt appropriate transfer mechanisms and, where required, implement supplementary safeguards to ensure a level of protection for personal data that is essentially equivalent to that guaranteed within the European Union.

8. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

The Company informs you that, as a data subject, you are entitled, at any time and subject to any limitations provided for by applicable law, to exercise the rights granted under Articles 15 to 22 of the GDPR, including the right to:

- Obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning you are being processed and, where that is the case, to access such data in an intelligible form (Article 15 of the GDPR).
- Obtain information and, where applicable, a copy of a) the origin and categories of the personal data; b) the logic involved where processing is carried out by automated means; c) the purposes and methods of the processing; d) the identity and contact details of the Controller and any Data Processors; e) the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be disclosed, in particular recipients in third countries or international organizations; f) where possible, the period for which the personal data will be stored, or, if that is not possible, the criteria used to determine that period; g) the existence of automated decision-making, including profiling, and, where applicable, meaningful information about the logic involved, as well as the significance and the envisaged consequences of such processing for you; h) the appropriate safeguards applied where personal data are transferred to a third country or an international organization.
- **Obtain, without undue delay, the rectification** of inaccurate personal data concerning you and, considering the purposes of the processing, the completion of incomplete personal data (Article 16 of the GDPR).
- **Obtain the erasure** of your personal data, anonymization where appropriate, or the restriction of processing where: a) the data have been processed unlawfully; b) the data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed; c) you withdraw your consent and there is no other legal basis for the processing; d) you object to the processing and there are no overriding legitimate grounds for continuing the processing; e) the data must be erased to comply with a legal obligation; f) the personal data were collected in relation to the offer of information society services to a child.

The Controller may refuse a request for erasure only where processing is necessary for: a) exercising the right to freedom of expression and information; b) compliance with a legal obligation or the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority; c) reasons of public

- interest in the area of public health; d) archiving purposes in the public interest, scientific or historical research purposes, or statistical purposes; e) the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims (Article 17 of the GDPR).
- Obtain restriction of processing where: a) you contest the accuracy of the personal data; b) the processing is unlawful and you oppose the erasure of the data; c) the Controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of the processing, but you require them for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims; d) you have objected to the processing pending verification of whether the Controller's legitimate grounds override your own (Article 18 of the GDPR).
 - Receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format and, where technically feasible, have those data transmitted directly to another controller, where the processing is based on consent or on a contract and is carried out by automated means (Article 20 of the GDPR).
 - Object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time to the processing of your personal data where such processing is based on the legitimate interests of the Controller or on another applicable legal basis, as provided for in Article 21 of the GDPR.
 - Lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority. In Italy, this is the Italian Data Protection Authority (Garante per la Protezione dei Dati Personali – www.garanteprivacy.it), headquartered at Piazza Venezia 11, 00187 Rome, Italy.

Where required by law, the Controller will inform any third parties to whom your personal data have been disclosed of any rectification, erasure, or restriction of processing requested by you, unless this proves impossible or involves a disproportionate effort.
